Mandate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Recommend policies, programs and new initiatives to promote and incorporate handbells and handchimes in elementary, secondary and post-secondary educational institutions. • Recommend policies, programs and new initiatives to promote and support private instruction in handbells and handchimes. • Develop networking opportunities for, and establish connections between, handbell and handchime educators. • Develop networking opportunities for, and establish connections between, handbell and handchime students in educational institutions and private instructional settings. • Evaluate the Guild's educational programs, and recommend program improvements.
Term	One year, ending at the first Board meeting after the adjournment of the Annual Meeting.
Duties	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Present, through the Chair, a Committee report at each Board Meeting, and at the Annual Meeting of Members. • Submit expenditure requests pertaining to Education initiatives, to be included in the Annual Budget. • Monitor the expenditure of funds authorized by the Annual Budget pertaining to Education. • Advise the Board on Education issues. • Recommend new initiatives in the area of Education. • Assist in implementing Board resolutions that fall within the jurisdiction of the Committee. • Keep minutes of each meeting of the Committee.
Remuneration	Committee members will serve without remuneration, provided that they may be paid reasonable expenses incurred in the performance of their duties as a Committee member.
Meeting Frequency	The Committee will meet no less than three times per year, including meeting at least one month before each Regular Board meeting.
